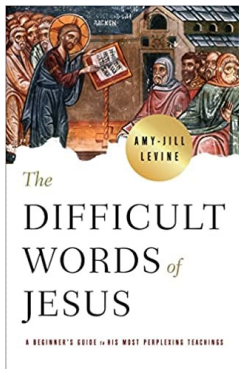

YOU MAKE A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF OTHERS

Families Forward. Bidwell Riverside reports they were fortunate to have had tremendous assistance from their supporters this last year and weathered the pandemic as well as possible. Their Food and Clothing Pantry continues to be the largest serving food pantry in Iowa and is a one-stop-shop for essential needs including diapers, baby food, clothing, toiletries and household goods. All of this, as well as food, is available for free to anyone who walks through the doors.

In July 2023, Bidwell Riverside and Hawthorn Hill will merge and the name for the new organization is Families Forward.

Bidwell Riverside programs: Food & Clothing Pantry and Child Development Center will continue to operate and the program names will stay the same. Hawthorn Hill programs: New Directions Shelter and The Home Connection will also continue.

With the merger, there will be a total of four programs serving those in need under one organization – **Families Forward.**

Free Little Food Pantry. *Thank you to everyone who has donated* non-perishable food items for the Free Little Food Pantry. The need continues to grow and we will donate **30 food items per week.** This will only be possible with your continued donations to the Free Little Food Pantry.

YOUR HELP IS NEEDED TO: Bring a donation of one or more food products each Sunday to New Hope and put on our pantry shelf located by the Welcome Center in the hallway. These items may include canned meats, canned fruit, canned vegetables, peanut butter, cereal, rice, grains, dry beans of all types, Ramen Noodles, soup, Chef Boyardee products with meat, spaghetti sauce, spaghetti noodles, pasta, etc. Only non-perishable foods and no expired food products. A grocery check list is on the pantry shelf to assist you in your shopping.

Sign up for a Monday to take the food products from the pantry shelves at New Hope and deliver to the Free Little Food Pantry located between 51st and 52nd Streets north of Meredith Drive. There is a clipboard with the sign-up sheet on the shelf. You can pick out your 30 choices on Sunday and deliver any time of the day on Monday.

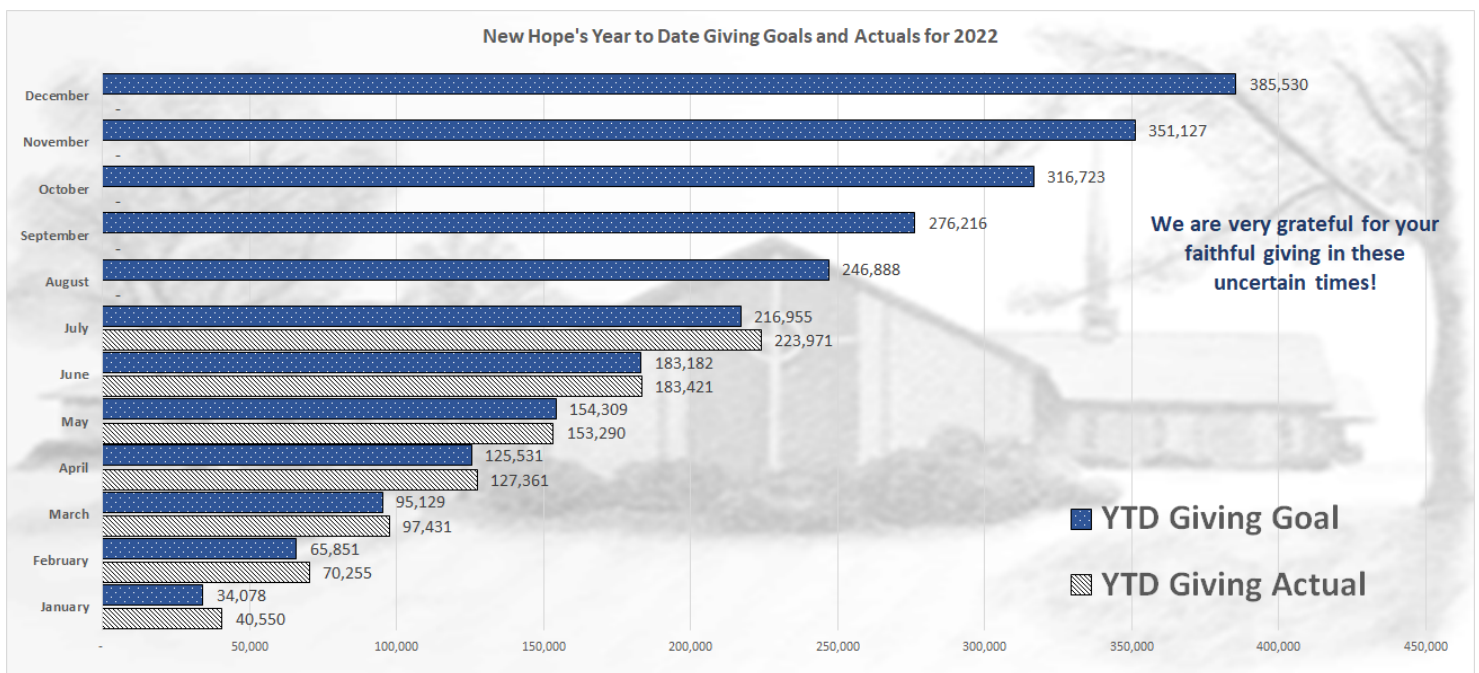
